



**SUBJ: GEOS VIRUS, sort of.... (R11) FROM: MichaelS30 04/23/90 S#: 52087**

There is sort of problem with using downloads with GEOS. It even catches veteran GEOS users occassionally. BUT ITS NOT A VIRUS, merely a system quirk.

What happens is that a GEOS disk all of the sudden won't open. Every attempt to open the disk causes the desktop to return a READ ERROR on some meaningless TRACK and SECTOR. You can see the first page of files and all the associated icons, but the desktop just won't let you do anything with them.

(By now most of the "GEOS PROS" know where this message is going...)

What went wrong? This disk worked yesterday!!

Most likely you downloaded a file, or maybe used a "native" CBM program, which TRASHED the disk geos border sector. For some reason this sector must be marked free in the disk's BAM because it always seems it is chosen by any non-geos disk writes.

Thankfully, there is a "treatment". You'll need to find one of the "unGEOS" programs to remove the information that identifies the disk a GEOS disk. When this is done you can now open the disk (and re-convert it to GEOS format). You'll probably want to validate (under desktop of course) the disk, just to be safe. One problem with this solution, any files that were on the border are now lost on your disk. The files are still there (at least until you validated the disk) but the directory information no longer exist.

**SUBJ: 2 Meg REU Upgrade.****FROM: Geojoec 03/22/90 S#: 42595**

Are you interested in getting your 17XX REU expanded to 1 or 2 megabytes using the 256 X 4 DRAMS? This means 2 megs only use up 16 chip spaces. The same as the 1750. It also uses much less power than if you used 41256's!

The price from the place I'm having mine done is \$150 for 1 meg and \$250 for 2 megs!

When you consider it costs \$50 to \$100 just to get a 1764 up to 512K, this is a real deal! Twice to 4 times the memory of a 1750.

Whats more, if you have an old 1700 you can get it upgraded to 2 megs for \$250 as well!

called "RAMBOard". Please note that SSI does NOT \*MAKE\* the Super Snapshot. LMS Technologies in Canada makes it. Might someone have gone over someone else's head on this one?

\* About this time, most people know it. GeoBASIC is (supposedly) going to be released by RUN MAGAZINE sometime this June. Though MOST people don't realize that there are rumors flying about a new promotion that RUN or BSW might be trying to use with this product. Sources have said that one of the two companies will be hiring many of the more famous programmers for GEOS--to write some new utilities and programs using GEOBASIC exclusively. Let's hear it for'em!!!

\* BSW has long had an abbreviated name. "Berkeley Softworks" is just a little too much for most people to want to type OR write. You can worry no longer, as BSW is now considering a name change. The new, improved, SIMPLER name should be MUCH easier on those tired fingers of yours...

\* Look for a POLICE ACADAMY film, in which a female officer is tapping away at the Police computer, tracking two of her co-cops, while two more guys are behind her playing with a remote control and zipping the little tracking car on the screen all over town... Look closer. That "POLICE COMPUTER" is none other than a 64!!!

\* A close source to geoJOURNAL has let on to some people that it is possible to run both the geoRAM and the TurboMaster excellerator board TOGETHER. This would provide both the speed of a RAMDISK and the processing of a 4.09 mHz machine!

- \* As most all of you know by now, Compute's GAZETTE is no more. The JUNE '90 issue was their last one published. Compute has merged the magazine into their sister publication, COMPUTE! Too bad another publication has chosen to ignore the MILLIONS of C64/128 owners out there. On a similar note INFO magazine has gone all Amiga (dirty-word!), their July '90 issue was the last to include 8-bit coverage.
- \* Heard through the "grapevine" that Berkeley has sent GEOPUBLISH 128 off to a third-party developer for completion. Program is supposed to take advantage of the 2 mhz. speed and 80 column support in the C128.
- \* The popular programs from Roger Lawhorn, GEOLABEL and GEOPRINT are about to be upgraded to new versions. The upgrades will add some new tricks and make these programs even more powerful. Also from the same programmer, a patch to the GEOS kernel that will add a multi-chooser box. Called SUPERBOX, this add-on will allow you to pick from the first 255 (!) files on your disk.
- \* Berkeley is just about ready to start BETA-testing the new GEOS-like program for the IBM market. Word has it that marketing will be directed at the millions of low-end XT-class computers still in use.
- \* The on-again off-again rumored C65GS computer has been shelved for good. Commodore marketing has decided the big "push" should be in getting the Amiga(dirty word, again!) into the mass marketing outlets as quickly as possible. Sources said they were concerned this new C65 would be in competition with their own products. Look for the Amiga to start showing up in K-Mart and Toys R Us before Christmas.

## Let's Expand Memory

Andrew E. Mileski has developed a way to expand the capacity of the 1750 REU to 1 or even 2 MEGS ! Unlike Paul Bosacki's miracle which allows only the C64 to access memory up to 1 meg internally, Andrew's expansion allows both C64 and C128 users the ability to access up to 2 megs off the REU.

The REU was originally designed to access 512kb of expansion memory, but Andrew has found a way to enable the REU to access more memory by "fooling" the REU into thinking it has only 512kb of memory. So by "tricking" the REU into thinking it is four separate REU's, it can be expanded to access up to 2 megs.

The instructions include installing a switch which allows you to enable or disable memory so you have complete 1750 REU software compatibility. Also included are instructions to install two Light Emitting Diodes (LED's) that shows what bank of 512k is being accessed. The LED's are also useful for early detection of software compatibility.

All the hardware for this expansion fits inside the REU case, though you will not be able to use the RF shield when done.


Andrew notes that most software will function with the extra memory enabled, INCLUDING GEOS!! Jim Collette has written a new patched DESKTOP V2.1 which will allow expanded REU's to have a RAM 1581 drive. More improvements are in the works for this new DESKTOP including the ability to have a shadowed 1581.

(editors note: The file described above is called Beyond 512K by Andrew Mileski. It includes a Geopaint schematic of the circuit. It's available to download as BEYOND512K.SDA on BBS Enterprise)






