

KeyDos

I have purchased the KeyDos Rom from AntigraV Toolkit and as soon as I can get it installed in the REU, test it, and learn the operation of it, I will set up a date for a demonstration. I have used it for editing Color 64 Version 128 in the Commodore 128D. It makes things faster to load and use with the built-in menus. It makes editing of files, overlays, sequential file, and printing a snap. It has a built-in Ram-Dos for the Reu that covers the ones modified up to 2 megs. I think it will be a pleasure to use in the 128's. More on this later. Well worth the \$32.50 purchase price if you own a 128.



