

Supports all printers supported by The Print Shop™ and PrintMaster™ except Commodore 1525 and MPS 801.

For Print Shop Users:

- 1. Load The Print Shop.
- Select GREETING CARD, SIGN, LETTERHEAD, or BANNER from the main menu and press return.
- 3. Highlight DESIGN YOUR OWN from the following menu and press return.
- To choose a graphic, select FROM OTHER DISK at the CHOOSE A GRAPHIC menu. Type in the name of the graphic you wish or press return for a disk listing.
 - If using the IBM Print Shop, choose a graphic by selecting FROM OTHER DISK at the CHOOSE A GRAPHIC LIBRARY menu. Select the option beginning with GR. Do not select ULIB.
- 5. Some Graphics Scrapbook chapters offer additional fonts, borders and full-panel displays. For the IBM and Commodore versions of Graphics Scrapbook, fonts, borders and full-panel displays are on the front side of the disk. For the Apple version, fonts, borders and full-panel displays are on the back side of the disk and will need to be flipped when importing.
 - To use the available fonts and borders, you must own a Print Shop that accepts fonts and borders from another disk. Full-panel displays are accepted by all versions of Print Shop.
- To choose a font or border, select FROM OTHER DISK at the CHOOSE A FONT or BORDER menu. Type in the name of the font or border you wish or press return for a disk listing.
 - If using an Apple version of Print Shop that has been updated via The Print Shop Companion or Holiday disk, select FROM OTHER DISK at the CHOOSE A FONT or BORDER menu. Remove The Print Shop and insert the Companion or Holiday disk in the disk drive. Hit return. Next, insert the Graphics Scrapbook disk and type in the name of the graphic you wish (Note—You need to follow this procedure only once each time you operate The Print Shop).
- To use the full-panel displays, select SCREEN MAGIC and follow the prompts to SELECT ACTIVITY. Choose GET SCREEN and insert your Graphics Scrapbook disk into your disk drive. Follow the prompts to print.
- 8. You can also modify the graphics by selecting GRAPHIC EDITOR from the main menu. Follow the prompts and select FROM OTHER DISK. Type or highlight the name of the graphic you want and modify. Then save the modified graphic to another disk.

For PrintMaster Users:

- 1. Load PrintMaster.
- Select SIGN, STATIONERY, GREETING CARD, BANNER or CALENDAR from the main menu and press return.
- 3. Highlight DESIGN YOUR OWN from the following menu and press return.
- 4. At the CHOOSE A GRAPHIC menu, select FROM OTHER DISK, FROM A GALLERY, or ANOTHER DISK. Highlight the graphic you wish to print.
- 5. To modify a graphic, select GRAPHIC EDITOR from the main menu. Follow the prompts and select FROM OTHER DISK, FROM A GALLERY, or ANOTHER DISK. Highlight the graphic you want, modify, then save to another disk.
- Some Graphics Scrapbook chapters offer additional fonts, borders and full-panel displays. To
 use the available fonts and borders, you must own PrintMaster Plus. Full-panel displays are not
 accepted by PrintMaster or PrintMaster Plus.

For IBM PrintMaster Plus Users:

- 1. Load PrintMaster Plus.
- 2. Select POSTER, STATIONERY, CARD, BANNER or CALENDAR.
- 3. Highlight the option beginning with NEW.
- 4. Select either BORDER, TEXT or GRAPHIC. Press return and choose ANOTHER DISK. Highlight the border, text or graphic you want.
- To modify a graphic from PrintMaster Plus, select DRAWING PAD from the main menu. Choose option "L", followed by ANOTHER DISK. Highlight the graphic you wish to modify and save.
