

Loading Instructions

1. Put the Outrageous Pages Program/Printer Disk working copy in the drive and close the disk drive door.
2. Enter LOAD"OP",8,1 and press
3. When prompted to insert the key disk, be sure one of the disks with the "key" on the label is in the drive, and press
4. When prompted for the Working Product Copy, insert your working copy of the Program/Printer Disk and press
5. When the program is through loading, the "Enter Program" and "Create Page Disk" options will appear. Click on the appropriate box and follow the screen prompts.

Outrageous Pages cannot load PaperClip files from a 1571-formatted disk.

Be careful when placing multiple copies of an image over the original. Moving the position box over the original and making multiple copies can distort the copy image.
